## **Goal Setting Key Points**

- You should formulate ideas on what you would like to accomplish
  - Short term
  - Long term
- You will need a plan on how to accomplish them
- You will need a way to determine if/when you accomplish a particular goal

**S**pecific

Measurable

Achievable

Realistic



## Goals: An important question

### How do you know you have achieved your goal?

- Scope is it specific or is it too general?
- Time frame is there a realistic time frame?
  - Have you given yourself too much time?
  - Not enough time?
- Benchmarks is your goal measurable?
  - What does it mean to "learn a new language"?
  - Is there a specific level of proficiency you are aiming for?
  - What kind of proficiency do you want? Reading? Speaking?

- What you want your students to learn or to be able to do
- How you plan curriculum (long term and day to day)

#### Institutional and/or Program Goals

Curricular goals that your university or language department has
